All of the critical operations, such as the shaping of the bracing, are done by guitarmakers with years of experience. The guitars are checked every step of the way by skilled inspectors to avoid defects in the finished product. When an Ibanez guitar is strung up and tuned at the end of the line we're sure that it represents the best value in acoustic guitars that you can buy.

The complete line of Ibanez acoustic guitars allows you to choose whatever features you like the best. The construction is sound and durable, but sound is still the major criterion. Ibanez has improved upon the many accepted economies of guitar construction to get the maximum performance for the most modest cost.

The most effective cost reduction method applied to acoustic guitars is the use of laminated woods. And while laminated woods cannot match the long term performance of solid woods, they can come very close. Most manufacturers use attractive veneers where you can see them, but in the interior laminations, use whatever is cheapest.

This is fine if you're buying looks, but a guitar should have a pleasing and full-toned color. While we do offer solid tops on some models, most Ibanez acoustics use laminated tops. However, the Ibanez top differs from others in that all the laminations are spruce. This construction allows you to own a guitar that won't crack or split when the weather changes, but will give you sound and projection nearly equal to guitars costing many dollars more.

With other construction innovations, like the Ibanez scalloped bracing system, we are confident that you can buy a better value in acoustic guitars than anyone.
