## A tighter grip on tuning.

Fitting easily into the bridge cavity, the Hipshot Trem-setter® adds tuning stability to the existing tremolo system. It returns the tremolo to the exact "zero" position. You can play right-hand bridge harmonics, aggressive rhythm parts or mute strings and the bridge remains stable. In other words, the bridge won't move until you want it to—not when you're bending strings or resting your hand on it. All the advantages of a non-tremolo bridge. And when you combine the Trem-setter with our celebrated American Standard tremolo bridge, you've got the best of all worlds.

## A complete system makes staying in tune easier.

Moving up the neck, the Fender/Wilkinson roller nut lets strings glide through the nut,



reducing friction and binding. The advanced design lets strings roll with the tension instead of resisting it. The system is completed by our high precision locking keys. These special tuning machines feature zero post movement, which means no backlash, and they lock your strings to the string posts, eliminating excess string wrap. So tuning remains stable without locking strings at the nut.

## Picking up where pickups left off.

The Fender-Lace Sensor® (available in four versions) features a patented magnetic field design that delivers the broad tonal range you expect from single-coil pickups—but without the noise. And without the annoying magnetic "string pull," it's got increased sustain and improved tuning stability. You'll not only dupli-

cate your favorite pickup sounds, but you'll get higher output, more accurate string balance, truer harmonics and overtones.
